FROM THEORY TO PRACTICE

After laying the theoretical and methodological foundations in previous phases of the project, Work Package 4 (WP4) marks a turning point: it brings the Stories4All approach directly into educational practice.

WP4 aims to bring digital storytelling into classrooms by equipping teachers with practical tools, training, and guidance. Through an online course and a teacher's guide, educators can create and apply inclusive, creative storytelling scenarios across the curriculum.

TARGET GROUP

The project is targeting all levels of education: early childhood, secondary preservice and inservice teachers.

The project supports them in developing skills to create inclusive, culturally aware learning activities using digital storytelling.

WHAT HAS BEEN COMPLETED



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An **online survey** among pre-service teachers helped identify key needs and attitudes towards digital storytelling.

Literature reviews provided a broader context on educational practices and policies, forming the basis for the training and tools now in use.

THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

On July 8th, 2024, project partners gathered in Warsaw for a meeting hosted by the University of Warsaw to review the results achieved so far, coordinate WP4 tasks, and prepare for the pilot phase.



WHAT'S NEXT?

The main activity of WP 4 is the development of the training program for teachers using the S4All methodology.

The online training program consists of **5 modules**.

- 1 Learning design, implementation, evaluation
- 2 Design thinking and its application
- 3 Digital tools
- 4 Interculturality, inclusion and diversity language learning
- 5 Using digital storytelling in TEYL

Online Training Programme will be offered on the Stories4All community platform Coursevo, where teachers can prepare, upload, search and remix digital tools and materials that can be used to develop stories. The platform will be accessible even after the projects ends, securing the sustainability of the project.

COMING UP! ONSITE TEACHER TRAINING IN GREECE



Our next in-person meeting will take place in September 2025 in Greece. Teachers who can't attend onsite can join remotely. It will include a hands-on training event for teachers from all partner countries.

Participants will have the opportunity to practice digital storytelling activities, present their pilot implementations, and reflect on shared experiences.



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
